The background

Towards an Excellent Service (TAES) for Parks and Open Spaces, is a parks specific version of the Excellence model that has helped transform the performance of cultural services and the perceptions about their impact on communities over recent years.

Using TAES can be the key to better representation in Comprehensive Area Assessments (CAA), Local Area Agreements (LAA), Multi Area Agreements (MAA), Regional Improvement and Efficiency Partnerships (RIEPS), and Regional Cultural Consortiums and can help park and green space services compete with other cultural services in the political and economic arenas where the critical decisions about investment priorities are being made.

Following the success of last year's 'Implementing TAES' training courses, GreenSpace, supported by CABE Space and Communities and Local Government (CLG), can now offer further opportunities to access TAES Training. Discounts are available for IPGS/LPGSF members and for organisations wishing to attend both courses.

Implementing TAES 25 January 2010

The focus

This one day course will provide an overview of the parks and open space version of the business excellence framework and the skills and techniques required to implement it.

The objectives

By the end of the training day it is intended that participants should have:

- An understanding of the concepts of excellence and continuous improvement
- Skills for scoping and planning their self-assessment
- Basic skills to carry out self-assessment
- Basic skills to develop a self improvement plan
- Awareness of the options available for external validation

Peer-Led Challenge 15 & 16 Febary 2010

The focus

This two day course is designed to ensure that people have the skills to conduct robust, challenging and valuable Peer-led Challenge, and to play a lead role in their organisation's Self-Assessment workshops. The Peer-Led Challenge course follows on from and builds on the learning from the Implementing TAES course.

The objectives

The delegates will leave the course with the following:

- Enhanced insight to – and passion for - Excellence and continuous improvement
- A clear perspective on the goals of the TAES Programme
- Clarity in relation to conducting effective Self-Assessment
- Enhanced insight relating to the TAES Benchmark
- A clear understanding of the Peer-Led Challenge process and techniques
- The skills to conduct effective and robust Peer-Led Challenge
- An agreed Peer-Led Challenge structure (which London Borough will challenge which London Borough)
